

CHAPTER 1. GENERAL

DIVISION I DEFINITIONS

Section 1.01 Applicant means the person or his/her authorized agent making application for water service. [Amended by Ord. No. 79 §1, eff. 10/07/2007.]

Section 1.02 Board means the Board of Directors of the District.

Section 1.03 Building is any structure used for human habitation or a place of business, recreation or other purpose containing sanitary and water facilities.

Section 1.04 Building Sewer is any sewer or drain beginning at the plumbing or drainage outlets of any buildings and running to the property line.

Section 1.05 Contractor is an individual, firm, corporation, partnership or association duly licensed by the State of California to perform the type of work to be done.

Section 1.06 Cost means the cost of labor, material, transportation, supervision, legal, engineering and all other necessary overhead expenses.

Section 1.07 County means the County of Placer.

Section 1.08 Cross-Connection means any physical connection between the piping system from the District service and that of any other water supply that is not, or cannot be, approved as safe and potable for human consumption, whereby water from the unapproved source may be forced or drawn into the District distribution mains.

Section 1.09 Customer means any person to whom water and sewer service is provided through the District's water and sewer systems. [Amended by Ord. No. 79 §1, eff. 10/07/2007.]

Section 1.10 Distribution Mains means water lines in streets, highways, alleys and easements used for fire protection or general distribution of water.

Section 1.11 District means Sierra Lakes County Water District.

Section 1.12 District Code means the codification of all District ordinances.

Section 1.13 District Office means the office of the District located at 7300 Short Road, Soda Springs, California.

Section 1.14 Engineer is the Engineer appointed by and acting for the Board and shall be a Registered Civil Engineer.

Section 1.15 Garbage is solid wastes from the preparation, cooking and dispensing of food, and from the handling, storage and sale of produce.

Section 1.16 Industrial Wastes are the liquid wastes from industrial processes as distinct from sewage.

Section 1.17 Lake Water means untreated water of Lake Serena and/or Lake Dulzura.

Section 1.18 Lake Water Service - *stricken entirely* [Amended by Ord. No. 79 §1, eff. 10/07/2007.]

Section 1.19 Lateral Sewer is the portion of the side sewer within a public street.

Section 1.20 Manager means either the General Manager and/or the Operations Manager, as such shall be determined by the Board from time to time.

Section 1.21 Outside Sewer is a private sewer beyond the limits of the District.

Section 1.22 Owner means the person owning the fee, or the person in whose name the legal title to the premises appears, by deed duly recorded in the County Recorder's office, or the person in possession of the premises or buildings under claim of, or exercising acts of ownership over same for himself, or as executor, administrator, guardian or trustee of the owner.

Section 1.23 Permit means any written authorization required pursuant to any rule, regulation, or ordinance of District for obtaining water service, or sewer service. [Amended by Ord. No. 79 §1, eff. 10/07/2007.]

Section 1.24 Person means any human being, firm,

company, partnership, association, and private, public, or municipal corporation; the United States of America; the State of California; districts; and all political subdivisions and governmental agencies thereof.

Section 1.25 Plumbing System includes all plumbing fixtures and traps, or soil, waste, special waste and vent pipes, and all sanitary sewage and water pipes within the property lines of the premises.

Section 1.26 Premises means a lot or parcel of real property under one ownership, except that any separate structure under one roof shall be deemed a separate premises. Apartment houses, motels, office buildings and structures of like nature may be classified as single premises.

Section 1.27 Private Sewer is one which has an independent sewage disposal not connected with a public sewer and which accommodates one or more houses.

Section 1.28 Public Sewer is a sewer lying within a street and which is controlled by or under the jurisdiction of the District.

Section 1.29 Regular Water Service means water service and facilities rendered for normal domestic, commercial and industrial purposes on a permanent basis, and the water available therefor.

Section 1.30 Service or Service Connection means the pipe line and appurtenant facilities such as the curb stop, meter and meter box, if any, all used to extend water service from a distribution main to premises. Where services are divided at the curb or property line to serve several customers, each such branch service shall be deemed a separate service.

Section 1.31 Sewer is a pipe or conduit which carries sewage and/or industrial wastes to which storm, surface and ground waters are not intentionally admitted.

Section 1.32 Sewage is a combination of water-carried wastes from buildings and industrial establishments connected to sewage works of the District.

Section 1.33 Sewage Works are all facilities for collection, pumping, treating and disposing of sewage.

Section 1.34 Side Sewer is the part of the

horizontal piping beginning at the foundation wall of any building and terminating in the main sewer.

Section 1.35 Street is any public highway, road, street, avenue, alley, way, easement or right-of-way.

Section 1.36 Surplus Lake Water. *Stricken entirely*

Section 1.37 Temporary Water Service means water service and facilities rendered for construction work and other uses of limited duration, and the water available therefore.
