

DIVISION XI APPLICATION FOR REGULAR WATER SERVICE - WHERE
NO MAIN EXTENSION REQUIRED

Section 11.01 Application for Water Service.

Applications for regular water service, where no main extension is required, shall be made upon a form provided by the District. No connection to the District's water system shall be made until a Connection Permit therefor has been issued by the District pursuant to the District's rules and regulations for the issuance of water and sewer connection permits, as such may be amended from time to time. [Amended by Ord. No. 70, eff. 6/16/03]

Section 11.02 Undertaking of Applicant.

Such application will signify the applicant's willingness and intention to comply with the ordinances, rules and regulations of the District relating to regular water service and to make payment for such water service at the rates established by the Board from time to time.

Section 11.03 Payment of Water Primary Facility
Fee.

In addition to all other charges of the District, there shall be collected a water primary facility fee in the amount of \$1,825.00 per equivalent living unit at the time an applicant submits an application for water service. The term "equivalent living unit" is defined in Section 15.01 of Division XV of Chapter 2 of the District Code. [Amended by Ord. No. 70, eff. 6/16/03]

Section 11.04 Payment for Previous Service.

An application will not be accepted unless payment in full has been made for any water service previously rendered to the applicant by the District.

Section 11.05 Installation of Services.

The water service pipelines and other appurtenances installed and constructed by the applicant in order to receive District water service shall conform to the DISTRICT STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.

Section 11.06 Changes in Customer's Equipment.

Customers making any material change in the size, character or extent of the equipment or operations utilizing water service, or whose change in operations results in a large increase in the use of water, shall immediately give the District written notice of the nature of the change and, if necessary, submit a new application and pay any additionally required charges and fees, including but not limited to primary facility fees.

Section 11.07 Time Limit on a Connection Permit.

If connection to the District's water system is not made within the effective period of the building permit, the Connection Permit shall become void and no further work shall be done. The District shall refund the primary facility fee advanced by the applicant less 10% for administrative costs. [Amended by Ord. No. 70, eff. 6/16/03]
